

XIVER General Conditions of Purchase

1. Definitions

In this document:

"Affiliate(s)" means (i) in the case of XIVER, XIVER MEMS Foundry B.V. and (ii) in the case of XIVER and Supplier: any and all other companies, firms and legal entities with respect to which now or hereafter XIVER MEMS Foundry B.V. or Supplier respectively, directly or indirectly holds 50% or more of the nominal value of the issued share capital or 50% or more of the voting power at general meetings or has the power to appoint a majority of directors or otherwise to direct the activities of such company, firm or legal entity;

"Agreement" means the binding contract formed as described in Clause 2.1 herein;

"APAC" means the Middle Eastern, Asian and other Pacific countries;

"Applicable data protection law" means all applicable law pertaining to the Processing of Personal Data hereunder;

"Good Industry Practice" means the exhibition of behavioral attributes, including but not limited to skill, care, prudence and precaution and the use of technology, techniques and methodologies that a leading professional supplier of similar Goods or Services would use;

"Goods" means both tangible and intangible goods, including software and related documentation and packaging;

"Intellectual Property Rights" (or **"IPRs"**) means patents, utility certificates, utility models, industrial design rights, copyrights, database rights, trade secrets, any protection offered by law to information, semiconductor IC topography rights and all registrations, applications, renewals, extensions, combinations, divisions, continuations or reissues of any of the foregoing or which otherwise arises or is enforceable under the laws of any jurisdiction or any bi-lateral or multi-lateral treaty regime;

"International Transactions Data" means any data regarding cross border transactions of XIVER (possibly including countries in respect of which the United Nations, European Union and/or the United States of America have issued export control and sanctions restrictions, as applicable);

"LATAM" means the Latin American countries, excluding Argentina;

"Personal Data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual;

"XIVER" means the purchasing Affiliate of XIVER MEMS Foundry B.V. identified in XIVER' order and where applicable includes other Affiliates of XIVER;

"XIVER Information" means all information in any form about, or pertaining to, the business or operations of XIVER, its Affiliates, including but not limited to information on products, technology, IT operations, Intellectual Property Rights, know-how, financial information, customer data, Personal Data and data, results, materials, data structures and documentation accessed by Supplier in performing the Agreement or generated by (an IT system of Supplier) or accessed by Supplier in performing the Services;

"Processing" means any operation or set of operations performed or to be performed upon Personal Data, whether or not by automatic means, such as creation, access, collection, recording, organization, storage, loading, employing, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, displaying, use, disclosure, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, blocking, erasure or destruction (hereinafter also referred to as a verb **"Process"**);

"Open Source Software" means (1) any software that requires as a condition of use, modification and/or distribution of such software, that such software: (i) be disclosed or distributed in source code form; (ii) be licensed for the purpose of making derivative works; (iii) may only be redistributed free from enforceable IPRs; and/or (2) any software that contains, is derived from, or statically or dynamically links to, any software specified under (1);

"Services" means the services to be performed by Supplier for XIVER under the Agreement;

"Supplier" means each person or entity (including, where relevant, its Affiliates) that enters into the Agreement;

"Work Product" means all deliverables (including future deliverables) and other data, reports, works, inventions, know-how, software, improvements, designs, devices, apparatus, practices, processes, methods, drafts, prototypes, products and other work product or intermediate versions thereof produced or acquired by Supplier, its personnel or its agents for XIVER in the performance of Services under the Agreement.

2. Formation of the Agreement

2.1. These General Conditions of Purchase, together with the relevant Purchase Order issued by XIVER, set forth the terms under which XIVER's offers to purchase Goods and/or Services from Supplier. When Supplier accepts XIVER's offer, either by acknowledgement, delivery of any Goods and/or commencement of performance of any Services, a

binding contract shall be formed. Such Agreement is limited to these General Conditions of Purchase as specified on the face and reverse of this document, the relevant Purchase Order and any attachments. XIVER does not agree to any proposed amendment, alteration, or addition by Supplier. The Agreement can be varied only in writing signed by XIVER. Any other statement or writing of Supplier shall not alter, add to, or otherwise affect the Agreement.

- 2.2. All costs incurred by Supplier in preparing and submitting any acceptance of XIVER's offer shall be for the account of Supplier.

3. Time of the Essence

Time is of the essence and all dates referred to in the Agreement shall be firm. In the event that Supplier anticipates any difficulty in complying with any delivery date or any of its other obligations under the Agreement, Supplier shall promptly notify XIVER in writing.

4. Delivery of Goods

- 4.1. Unless expressly agreed otherwise in writing, all Goods shall be delivered FCA (named port or place of departure) except that maritime transport shall be delivered FOB (named port of shipment) (as defined in the Incoterms 2010) towards the final destination determined by XIVER.
- 4.2. Delivery shall be completed as per the applicable Incoterm, but this shall not constitute acceptance of the Goods.
- 4.3. Each delivery of Goods to XIVER shall include a packing list which contains at least (i) the applicable order number, (ii) the XIVER part number, (iii) the quantity shipped, and (iv) the date of shipment.
- 4.4. Supplier is allowed to make a partial delivery or delivery before the agreed delivery date(s) in case of a written agreement between Supplier and XIVER. XIVER reserves the right to refuse delivery of Goods and return the same at Supplier's risk and expense if Supplier defaults in the manner and time of delivery or in the rate of shipment. XIVER shall not be liable for any costs incurred by Supplier related to production, installation, assembly or any other work related to the Goods, prior to delivery in accordance with the Agreement.
- 4.5. Any design, manufacturing, installation or other work to be performed by or on behalf of Supplier under the Agreement shall be executed with good workmanship and using proper materials.
- 4.6. Supplier shall pack, mark and ship the Goods in accordance with sound commercial practices and XIVER's specifications in such manner as to prevent damage during transport and to facilitate efficient unloading, handling and storage, and all Goods shall be clearly marked as destined for XIVER. Notwithstanding the provisions of the applicable

Incoterms, Supplier shall be responsible for any loss or damage due to its failure to properly preserve, package, handle (before delivery as per the applicable Incoterm) or pack the Goods; XIVER shall not be required to assert any claims for such loss or damage against the common carrier involved.

5. Changes to Goods

Supplier shall not, without prior written consent of XIVER, make any changes affecting Goods, including process or design changes, changes to manufacturing processes (including geographic location), changes affecting electrical performance, mechanical form or fit, function, environmental compatibility, chemical characteristics, life, reliability or quality of Goods or changes that could have significant impact upon XIVER's quality system and business.

6. Inspection, Testing, Rejection of Goods

- 6.1. Inspection, testing of or payment for the Goods by XIVER shall not constitute acceptance. Inspection or acceptance of or payment for the Goods by XIVER shall not release Supplier from any of its obligations, representations or warranties under the Agreement.
- 6.2. XIVER may, at any time, inspect the Goods or the manufacturing process for the Goods. If any inspection or test by XIVER is made on the premises of Supplier, Supplier shall provide reasonable facilities and assistance for the safety and convenience of XIVER's inspection personnel.
- 6.3. If XIVER does not accept any of the Goods, Clause 10 below shall apply and Supplier shall collect the Goods from XIVER at its own expense. If Supplier does not collect the Goods within two weeks, XIVER may have the Goods delivered to Supplier at Supplier's cost, or with the Supplier's prior consent destroy the Goods, without prejudice to any other right or remedy XIVER may have under the Agreement or at law. Goods not accepted but already paid by XIVER shall be reimbursed by Supplier to XIVER within two weeks and XIVER shall have no payment obligation for any Good not accepted by XIVER.
- 6.4. If, as a result of sampling inspection, any portion of a lot or shipment of like or similar items is found not to conform to the Agreement, XIVER may reject and return the entire shipment or lot without further inspection or, at its option, complete inspection of all items in the shipment or lot, reject and return any or all nonconforming units (or accept them at a reduced price) and charge Supplier the cost of such inspection.

7. Performance of Services

- 7.1. Supplier shall perform the Services with due skill and care, using the proper materials and employing sufficiently qualified staff.
- 7.2. Supplier shall be fully liable for the acts and omissions of any and all third parties with which it has

contracted in connection with the Services.

- 7.3. Only written confirmation by XIVER shall constitute acceptance of the Services performed. If XIVER does not accept the Service and/or Work Product(s), Clause 10 below shall apply. XIVER shall promptly notify Supplier of such rejection, and Supplier will, at its own expense, carry out the necessary corrections, additions and modifications reasonably requested by XIVER in writing within thirty (30) days of such notification.

8. Prices, Payment

- 8.1. Unless provided otherwise in the Purchase Order, title in the Goods shall pass to XIVER at the time risk is transferred to XIVER pursuant to the applicable Incoterm.
- 8.2. All prices quoted in the Agreement shall be fixed prices. Supplier warrants that such prices are not in excess of the lowest prices charged by Supplier to other similarly situated customers for similar quantities of Goods or Services of like kind and quality.
- 8.3. (i) All prices are gross amounts but exclusive of any value added tax (VAT), sales tax, GST, consumption tax or any other similar tax only. (ii) If the transactions as described in the Agreement are subject to any applicable VAT, sales tax, GST, consumption tax or any other similar tax, Supplier may charge VAT, sales tax, GST, consumption tax or any other similar tax to XIVER, which shall be paid by XIVER in addition to the prices quoted. Supplier is responsible for paying any applicable VAT, sales tax, GST, consumption tax or any other similar tax to the appropriate (tax) authorities. At or after the time delivery has been completed as per Clause 4.2 but ultimately within six months from delivery, Supplier shall, in compliance with XIVER's instructions regarding the invoicing process, issue an invoice in electronic form meeting all applicable legal and fiscal requirements and which shall contain: (i) the XIVER purchase order number, and (ii) wording that shall allow XIVER to take advantage of any applicable "input" tax deduction. In addition, Supplier shall inform XIVER whether XIVER is allowed to apply for an exemption if and to the extent allowed under applicable law in such specific situation.
- 8.4. Any license fees shall be included in the price. Subject to the acceptance of the Goods, Services and/or Work Product by XIVER, and unless provided otherwise in the Purchase Order, payment shall be made as follows: within forty five (45) days from receipt of the correct invoice.
- 8.5. If Supplier fails to fulfill any of its obligations under the Agreement, XIVER may suspend payment to Supplier upon notice to Supplier.
- 8.6. Supplier hereby unconditionally accepts that XIVER and any of its Affiliates shall at all times have the right to set-off any amounts that any XIVER Affiliate

owes to Supplier or its Affiliates under this Agreement with any amounts that Supplier or its Affiliates owes to any Affiliate of XIVER under the Agreement or any other agreement.

- 8.7. Supplier acknowledges and agrees that any amount to be paid by XIVER to Supplier may be paid on XIVER's behalf by another Affiliate of XIVER and/or a third party designated by XIVER. Supplier shall treat such payment as if it were made by XIVER itself and XIVER's obligation to pay to Supplier shall automatically be satisfied and discharged in the amount paid by such entity or third party.

9. Warranty

- 9.1. Supplier represents and warrants to XIVER that all Goods and/or Work Product(s):
- (a) are suitable for the intended purpose and shall be new, merchantable, of good quality and free from all defects in design, materials, construction and workmanship;
 - (b) strictly comply with the specifications, approved samples and all other requirements under the Agreement;
 - (c) are delivered with all required licenses which shall remain valid and in place, and with the scope to properly cover the intended use. Furthermore, all such licenses shall include the right to transfer and the right to grant sublicenses;
 - (d) shall be free from any and all liens and encumbrances;
 - (e) shall not include any Open Source Software;
 - (f) have been designed, manufactured and delivered in compliance with all applicable laws (including ESG laws) and regulations;
 - (g) are provided with and accompanied by all information and instructions necessary for proper and safe use; including all its packaging and components supplied to XIVER comply with Regulated Substances in compliance with the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, Annex II amended by Directive (EU) 2015/863 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (also known as "RoHS 3") & Regulation EC 1907/2006 REACH; which Supplier will also adhere to future regulated Substances changes and will be fully compliant with the updated regulation in line with Article 33 of REACH; Supplier confirms that the (SVHC's) list will be evaluated on regular basis. Supplier will notify XIVER and the ECHA (as applicable) on the presence of any Candidate List substances in products that are supplied towards XIVER above the concentration of >0.1% by weight. The updated SVHC Candidate List of substances can be found at the URL below: <https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>

XIVER may reject deliveries that do not comply with these requirements; and deliveries will be accompanied by written and detailed specifications of the composition and characteristics, to enable XIVER to transport, store, process, use and dispose of such Goods and/or Work Product safely and in compliance with law.

- 9.2. These warranties are not exhaustive and shall not be deemed to exclude any warranties set by law, Supplier's standard warranties or other rights or warranties which XIVER may be entitled to. These warranties shall survive any delivery, inspection, acceptance, payment or resale of the Goods, and shall extend to XIVER and its customers.
- 9.3. Without prejudice to any other rights accruing under the Agreement or law, the warranties set forth in Clause 9.1 (a) and (b) will subsist for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date of delivery as per Clause 4.2, or such other period as agreed in the Agreement (the "Warranty Term"). Goods repaired or replaced within the Warranty Term are warranted for the remainder of the original Warranty Term of said Goods, or twelve (12) months following the delivery date of such repaired or replaced Goods, whichever is longer.

10. Non-conformity

- 10.1. If any Goods, Services or Work Products are defective, latent or otherwise do not conform to the requirements of the Agreement, XIVER shall notify Supplier and may, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to it under the Agreement or at law, at its sole discretion:
- (a) require performance by Supplier;
 - (b) require delivery of substitute Goods or Work Products;
 - (c) require Supplier to remedy the lack of conformity by repair;
 - (d) declare the contract rescinded; or
 - (e) reduce the price in the same proportion as the value of the Goods or Services actually delivered, even if that results in a full refund of the price paid to Supplier.
- 10.2. Supplier shall bear all cost of repair, replacement and transportation of the nonconforming Goods, and shall reimburse XIVER in respect of all costs and expenses (including, without limitation, inspection, handling and storage costs) reasonably incurred by XIVER in connection therewith.
- 10.3. Risk in relation to the nonconforming Goods shall pass to Supplier upon the date of notification thereof.

11. Ownership and Intellectual Property

- 11.1. All machinery, tools, drawings, specifications, raw materials and any other property or materials furnished to Supplier by or for XIVER, or paid for by

XIVER, for use in the performance of the Agreement, shall be and remain the sole exclusive property of XIVER and shall not be furnished to any third party without XIVER's prior written consent, and all information with respect thereto shall be confidential and proprietary information of XIVER. In addition, any and all of the foregoing shall be used solely for the purpose of fulfilling orders from XIVER, shall be marked as owned by XIVER, shall be held at Supplier's risk, shall be kept in good condition in safe storage and, if necessary, shall be replaced by Supplier at Supplier's expense, shall be subject to periodic inventory check by Supplier as reasonably requested from time to time by XIVER, and shall be returned promptly upon XIVER's first request. Except as otherwise expressly agreed in writing, Supplier agrees to furnish at its own expense all machinery, tools, and raw materials necessary to perform its obligations under the Agreement.

- 11.2. Supplier represents and warrants to XIVER that the Goods and Services do not and shall not, alone or in any combination, infringe or violate any third party (including Supplier's employees and subcontractors) IPRs.
- 11.3. The purchase of the Goods and/or Services shall confer on XIVER and its Affiliates an irrevocable, world-wide, royalty-free and fully paid up, non-exclusive and perpetual license under all IPRs owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by Supplier to use, make, have made, build-in, have built-in, market, sell, lease, license, distribute and/or otherwise dispose of the Goods and/or Services, including but not limited to machinery, tools, drawings, designs, software, demos, moulds, specifications or pieces.
- 11.4. XIVER shall retain all rights in any samples, data, works, materials and intellectual and other property provided by XIVER to Supplier. All rights in and titles to the Work Product shall become XIVER's property. Supplier shall execute and deliver any documents and do such things as may be necessary or desirable in order to carry into effect the provisions of this Clause 11.4.
- 11.5. Supplier shall not have any right, title or interest in or to any of XIVER's samples, data, works, materials, trademarks and intellectual and other property nor shall the supply of Goods and/or Services alone or in any combination, or the supply of packaging containing XIVER's trademarks or trade names give Supplier any right or title to these or similar trademarks or trade names. Supplier shall not use any trademark, trade name or other indication in relation to the Goods or Services alone or in any combination without XIVER's prior written approval and any use of any trademark, trade name or other indication as authorized by XIVER shall be strictly in accordance with the instructions of and for the purposes specified by XIVER.
- 11.6. Supplier shall not, without XIVER's prior written consent, publicly make any reference to XIVER,

whether in press releases, advertisements, sales literature or otherwise.

12. Intellectual Property Indemnification

- 12.1. Supplier shall indemnify and hold harmless XIVER, its Affiliates, agents and employees and any person selling or using any of XIVER's products in respect of any and all claims, damages, costs and expenses (including but not limited to loss of profit and reasonable attorneys' fees) in connection with any third party claim that any of the Goods or Services alone or in any combination or their use infringes any third party IPRs, or, if so directed by XIVER, shall defend any such claim at Supplier's own expense.
- 12.2. XIVER shall give Supplier prompt written notice of any such claim, provided, however, any delay in notice shall not relieve Supplier of its obligations hereunder except to the extent it is prejudiced by such delay. Supplier shall provide all assistance in connection with any such claim as XIVER may reasonably require.
- 12.3. If any Goods or Services alone or in any combination, supplied under the Agreement are held to constitute an infringement or if their use is enjoined, Supplier shall, as directed by XIVER, but at its own expense: either:
 - (a) procure for XIVER or customers the right to continue using the Goods or Services alone or in any combination; or
 - (b) replace or modify the Goods or Services alone or in any combination with a functional, non-infringing equivalent.
- 12.4. If Supplier is unable either to procure for XIVER the right to continue to use the Goods or Services alone or in any combination or to replace or modify the Goods or Services alone or in any combination in accordance with the above, XIVER may terminate the Agreement and upon such termination, Supplier shall reimburse to XIVER the price paid, without prejudice to Supplier's obligation to indemnify XIVER as set forth herein.

13. Indemnification

Supplier shall indemnify and hold harmless XIVER, its Affiliates, agents and employees and anyone selling or using any of XIVER' products, from and against all suits, actions, legal or administrative proceedings, claims, demands, damages, judgments, liabilities, interest, attorneys' fees, costs and expenses of whatsoever kind or nature (including but not limited to special, indirect, incidental, consequential damages), whether arising before or after completion of the delivery of the Goods or performance of the Services covered by the Agreement, in any manner caused or claimed to be caused by the acts, omissions, faults, breach of express or implied warranty, breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, or negligence of Supplier, or of anyone acting under its

direction or control or on its behalf, in connection with Goods, Services or any other information furnished by Supplier to XIVER under the Agreement.

14. Compliance with Laws

Supplier shall at all times comply with all laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances applicable to the Agreement, including, but not limited to, all fair labor, equal opportunity, and environmental compliance laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances. Supplier shall furnish to XIVER any information required to enable XIVER to comply with any applicable laws, rules, and regulations in its use of the Goods and Services. If Supplier is a person or legal entity doing business in the United States, and the Goods and/or Services are sold to XIVER under federal contract or subcontract, all applicable procurement regulations required by federal statute or regulation to be inserted in contracts or subcontracts are hereby incorporated by reference. Additionally, if Supplier is a person or legal entity doing business in the United States, the Equal Employment Opportunity Clauses set forth in 41 Code of Federal Regulations, Chapters 60-1.4, 60-250.5, and 60-741.5, are hereby incorporated by reference.

15. Privacy and Data Protection

- 15.1. For the performance of the Agreement, Supplier warrants that:
 - i. it will process personal data relating to or originating from XIVER only for the purpose(s) of providing the Goods or Services, managing the commercial relationship with XIVER and/or to comply with applicable laws. This includes activities such as performing Supplier's obligations under this Agreement and/or managing administration/billing and accounting operations.
 - ii. it will collect and further process the above-mentioned personal data independently and in compliance with applicable data protection laws.
 - iii. it will not process personal data on behalf and under the instructions of XIVER, without the prior written authorization of XIVER and without having separately agreed and signed with XIVER the data processing agreement required by applicable data protection law. XIVER reserves the right to enter into a data processing agreement with Supplier if deemed necessary for the purposes of compliance with applicable data protection law.
 - iv. it will not process personal data – relating to or originating from XIVER and received directly or indirectly from the European Economic Area ("EEA") or from XIVER's affiliates established in the EEA – in countries that are not member of the EEA or in countries that have not received a binding adequacy decision from the European Commission. If this is not possible, prior to processing the above-mentioned personal data in the restricted countries, Supplier shall inform XIVER and work with XIVER to

address any data transfer restriction in a mutually acceptable manner.

- v. it will give XIVER all reasonable assistance to enable XIVER to comply with applicable data protection laws.
- 16.2. XIVER hereby informs Supplier that it will process personal data relating to or originating from Supplier in accordance with the relevant section(s) of the XIVER Privacy Notice, available at <https://www.XIVER.com/privacy> (as updated from time to time).

16. Information Security

- 16.1 Ownership of the XIVER Information shall remain with XIVER and its Affiliates. Supplier may use the XIVER Information only for the performance of the Agreement and in accordance with XIVER's instructions. Supplier shall clearly mark the XIVER Information as property of XIVER.
- 16.2 Supplier shall establish an information security management framework to initiate and control the implementation of security policies, standards and procedures within Supplier's organization in order to protect XIVER Information and assets relevant to the Agreement (including any systems). Such framework shall be operated in accordance with Good Industry Practices and shall at a minimum include protection against loss, deterioration, corruption, unauthorized alteration and unauthorized access. Supplier shall protect XIVER Information and assets based on the principles of confidentiality, integrity and availability.

17. Export Controls Compliance

- 17.1 Supplier agrees and warrants that it will comply with all applicable international and national export control laws and regulations and it will not export or re-export, directly or indirectly, any information, goods, software and/or technology to any country for which the European Union or the United States of America or any other country, at the time of export or re-export, requires an export license or other governmental approval, without first obtaining such license or approval.
- 17.2 Supplier acknowledges that any data or other information processed by Supplier in light of its engagement by XIVER might be controlled information under export control laws and regulations and that it will not deal with said information in violation of such laws and regulations. Supplier shall ensure that: (a) International Transactions Data shall be stored on servers outside the United States of America ("US"); and (b) International Transactions Data shall be encrypted at rest and in transit.
- 17.3 Supplier agrees to inform XIVER in writing whether or not the supplied information, goods, software, technology, hosted application and/or Services are

US controlled and/or controlled under the export control laws of its own country, and if so, Supplier will inform XIVER about the extent of the restrictions (including but not limited to export control legal jurisdiction, export control classification numbers, export control licenses and/or CCATS as applicable).

- 17.4 Supplier shall obtain all international and national export licenses or similar permits required under all applicable export control laws and regulations and shall provide XIVER with all information required to enable XIVER and its customers to comply with such laws and regulations.
- 17.5 Supplier agrees to indemnify and hold XIVER harmless from any claims, liabilities, penalties, forfeitures, and associated costs and expenses (including attorney's fees), which XIVER may incur due to Supplier's non-compliance with applicable laws, rules and regulations. Supplier agrees to notify XIVER promptly of Supplier's receipt of any such notice of a violation of any export control related law, rule or regulation, which may affect XIVER.

18. Customs Compliance

- 18.1 For all Goods that qualify for application of Regional or Free Trade Agreements, General Systems of Preference or other preferential arrangements, it is the responsibility of the Supplier to deliver products with the appropriate documentary evidence (e.g. Supplier's declaration, preferential origin certificate/invoice declaration) to confirm the preferential origin status.
- 18.2 Supplier shall mark every Good (or the Good's container if there is no room on the Good itself) with the country of origin. Supplier shall, in marking the Goods, comply with the requirements of the customs authorities of the country of receipt. If any Goods are imported, Supplier shall when possible allow XIVER to be the importer of record. If XIVER is not the importer of record and Supplier obtains duty drawback rights to the Goods, Supplier shall, upon XIVER request, provide XIVER with documents required by the customs authorities of the country of receipt to prove importation and to transfer duty drawback rights to XIVER.

19. Limitation of Liability

- 19.1. Neither Party excludes or limits its liability for death or personal injury arising from its own negligence, fraud, or for any liability that cannot by law be excluded or limited.
- 19.2 Subject to Clause 19.1, IN NO EVENT SHALL XIVER BE LIABLE UNDER ANY THEORY OF LIABILITY, FOR INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, WHICH INCLUDES WITHOUT LIMITATION DAMAGES FOR LOST PROFITS OR REVENUES, LOST BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES, LOSS OF IMAGE OR LOST DATA, EVEN IF XIVER HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE

POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES and in no event shall XIVER be liable to Supplier, its successors or assigns for damages in excess of the amount due to Supplier for complete performance under the Agreement, less any amounts already paid to Supplier by XIVER.

20. Force Majeure

In the event that Supplier is prevented from performing any of its obligations under the Agreement for reason of force majeure (being an event unforeseeable and beyond the control of Supplier) and Supplier has provided sufficient proof for the existence of the force majeure, the performance of the obligation concerned shall be suspended for the duration of the force majeure. XIVER shall be entitled to terminate the Agreement with immediate effect by written notice to Supplier, immediately if the context of the non-performance justifies immediate termination, and in any event if the circumstance constituting force majeure endures for more than thirty (30) days and, upon such notice, Supplier shall not be entitled to any form of compensation in relation to the termination. Force majeure on the part of Supplier shall in any event not include shortage of personnel or production materials or resources, strikes, not officially declared epidemic or pandemic, breach of contract by third parties contracted by Supplier, financial problems of Supplier, nor the inability of Supplier to secure the necessary licenses in respect of software to be supplied or the necessary legal or administrative permits or authorizations in relation to the Goods or Services to be supplied.

21. Suspension and Rescission

- 21.1. Without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to XIVER under the Agreement or at law, XIVER shall be entitled at its discretion to suspend the performance of its obligations under the Agreement in whole or in part or to declare the Agreement rescinded in whole or in part by means of written notice to Supplier in the event that:
- (a) Supplier files a voluntary petition in bankruptcy or any voluntary proceeding relating to insolvency, receivership, liquidation, assignment for the benefit of creditors or similar proceeding;
 - (b) Supplier becomes the subject of a petition in bankruptcy or any proceeding relating to insolvency, receivership, liquidation, assignment for the benefit of creditors or similar proceeding;
 - (c) Supplier ceases or threatens to cease to carry on business in the ordinary course;
 - (d) Supplier breaches any of its obligations under the Agreement or XIVER, in its reasonable discretion, determines that Supplier cannot or shall not deliver the Goods or perform the Services as required; or
 - (e) Supplier fails to provide adequate assurance of

performance following request by XIVER.

22. Confidentiality

- 22.1. Supplier shall treat all information provided by or on behalf of XIVER or generated by Supplier for XIVER under the Agreement as confidential. All such information shall be used by Supplier only for the purposes of the Agreement. Supplier shall protect XIVER' information using not less than the same degree of care with which it treats its own confidential information, but at all times shall use at least reasonable care. All such information shall remain the property of XIVER and Supplier shall, upon XIVER' demand, promptly return to XIVER all such information and shall not retain any copy thereof.
- 22.2. The existence and the contents of the Agreement shall be treated as confidential by Supplier.

23. Miscellaneous

- 23.1. Supplier will maintain comprehensive or commercial general liability insurance (including products liability, property damage and personal injury liability, and any other liability as may be requested by XIVER) with, unless otherwise agreed by XIVER, a minimum limit of one million Euro for claims of bodily injury, including death, and any other damages that may arise from use of the Goods or Services or acts or omissions of Supplier under the Agreement. Such insurance policies will be written with appropriately licensed and financially responsible insurers. Supplier shall inform XIVER of any cancellation or reduction in coverage with a minimum of 30 days prior written notice. Certificates of insurance evidencing the required coverage and limits and insurance policies shall be furnished to XIVER upon XIVER' request.
- 23.2. Supplier shall provide Goods and render Services hereunder as an independent contractor and not as an agent of XIVER and nothing contained in the Agreement is intended to create a partnership, joint venture or employment relationship between the parties irrespective of the extent of economic dependency of Supplier on XIVER.
- 23.3. Supplier shall not subcontract, transfer, pledge or assign any of its rights or obligations under the Agreement without the prior written consent of XIVER. Any such pre-approved subcontracting, transfer, pledge or assignment shall be null and void and have no effect vis-à-vis such third party.
- 23.4. The rights and remedies reserved to XIVER are cumulative and are in addition to any other or future rights and remedies available under the Agreement, at law or in equity.
- 23.5. Supplier shall provide XIVER written notice of all product discontinuances twelve (12) months prior to the last order date, including as a minimum XIVER part numbers, substitutions, and last order and shipment dates.

- 23.6. Neither the failure nor the delay of XIVER to enforce any provision of the Agreement shall constitute a waiver of such provision or of the right of XIVER to enforce each and every provision of the Agreement. No course or prior dealings between the parties and no usage of the trade shall be relevant to determine the meaning of the Agreement. No waiver, consent, modification or amendment of the terms of the Agreement shall be binding unless made in a writing specifically referring to the Agreement signed by XIVER and Supplier.
- 23.7. In the event that any provision(s) of these General Conditions of Purchase and of the Agreement shall be held invalid, unlawful or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction or by any future legislative or administrative action, such holding or action shall not negate the validity or enforceability of any other provisions of the Agreement. Any such provision held invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, shall be substituted by a provision of similar import reflecting the original intent of the clause to the extent permissible under applicable law.
- 23.8. All terms and conditions of the Agreement which are destined, whether express or implied, to survive the termination or the expiration of the Agreement, including but not limited to Warranty, Intellectual Property, Confidentiality and Personal Data, shall survive.
- 23.9. The Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the country or state in which the XIVER ordering entity is located, as applicable.
- 23.10. Supplier and XIVER each consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts in (i) the country or state in which the XIVER ordering entity is located; or (ii) at the option of XIVER, the jurisdiction of the entity of Supplier to which the order was placed, or (iii) at the option of XIVER, for arbitration in which case Clause 23.11 applies. Supplier hereby waives all defenses of lack of personal jurisdiction and forum non-convenience.
- 23.11. If so chosen by XIVER in accordance with Clause 23.10, any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, or their breach, termination or invalidity shall be finally settled solely under the International Chamber of Commerce Rules of arbitration, which Supplier and XIVER declare to be known to them. Supplier and XIVER agree that: (i) the appointing authority shall be the ICC-International Chamber of Commerce of Paris, France; (ii) there shall be three (3) arbitrators; (iii) arbitration shall take place in the jurisdiction of the XIVER ordering entity or, at the option of XIVER, the jurisdiction of the Supplier's entity having received the order; (iv) the language to be used in the arbitration proceedings shall be English; and (v)

the material laws to be applied by the arbitrators shall be the laws as determined under Clause 23.9.

- 23.12. The United Nations Convention on International Sale of Goods shall not apply to the Agreement.

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
